



Internship & Transition Program

The Internship & Transition Program is designed for individuals with and without special education needs who have an interest in working with young children and developing job-related skills for part or full-time employment. Interns will have a One World School mentor and will be required to volunteer 10 to 15 hours per week and participate in 2 to 3 hours per week of Transition Classes. Interns who successfully complete at least one full year of this program may be eligible for paid part or full time employment with One World School.

Eligibility

- Individuals with and without special education needs
- Half to full year Program: High school diploma or equivalent and/or 18+ years old
- Summer Program: 15+ years old
- Interest in volunteering, service learning, and working with young children with and without special education needs
- Interest in developing job-related skills for part or full time employment
- Complete and submit the Internship & Transition Program forms (downloadable)
 - Student Information
 - Confidential Evaluations (2)
 - Medical Clearance
- Interview with One World School
- Ability to commit to ½ year (20 weeks) to a full year (40 weeks) of internship and transition classes

Internship Requirements

- Volunteer 10 to 15 hours per week in areas of interest (e.g. Preschool Program, Individualized Education Program, Media Center, and/or Arts & Music Program)
- Participate in One World School's service learning program
- Work with a One World School mentor (e.g. Administrator, Faculty, and/or Secretary)
- Participate in self- and mentor evaluations to develop job-related skills

Transition Program

- All interns are eligible to participate in the Transition Program.
- The Transition Program includes 2 to 3 hours per week of Transition Classes focused on developing job-related skills.

Benefits

- Individuals who successfully complete at least one full year of the Internship & Transition Program may be eligible for paid part or full time employment with One World School.
